ACADEMIC SUPPORT AND INTERNSHIP SEMINAR

Spring 2023 semester has begun and we are so thrilled to have students back with us on campus! Academic Support will continue to be divided up between cohorts; Cohort 3 will be learning about "Transition to Employment" and Cohort 4 will be learning about "Interpersonal Communication". Within both of the cohorts, we have partnered with Missouri State University Occupational Therapy (MSU OT). MSU OT students will work with Program Coordinator Caleb Hatz to pair their learning goals (e.g. Social, Emotional, Spiritual, Intellectual, Physical, Environmental, Financial, and Occupational) with Bear POWER's theme for Academic Support and devise various groups to achieve these goals. We think this will be a great pairing for all parties involved.

All students are also starting their internships for Spring 2023! We are excited for Cohort 4 to begin their internships within their respective areas. We look forward to continuing our partnerships with the following internship locations: MSU Faculty Center for Teaching and Learning, MSU Telecommunications, MSU Child Development Center, MSU Library, MSU Residence Life, MSU Maintenance, and Stormdar Connect.

INTERNSHIPS
