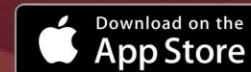

- Meal Swipes can be used once every 30 minutes.
- Either portion of the Meal Plan Package can be lowered during the first 3 weeks of each semester and increased at any time.
- Unused Dining Dollars roll from Fall to Spring - they all expire at the end of the Spring Semester.

ALLERGENS

- Our entire team takes FareCheck training annually to make sure that we are up to date on all relevant and emerging food allergies.
- Each of our locations have Ingredient Experts that are available to talk with students about ingredients in menu items.
- Each Dining Center has a station that offers a menu avoiding the 9 major allergens.
- Students are always welcome to reach out to us and schedule a meeting with our team to discuss their allergens and dietary needs.



HEALTH AND SAFETY

- All Missouri State Dining Managers, Culinarians and Supervisors are ServSafe trained and certified in food service safety.
- All Missouri State Dining Team Members must undergo regular food safety training.
- All equipment is regularly cleaned, disinfected and sanitized during each shift.

WHEN DO STUDENTS MOVE IN?

- Centralized process to get keys
- If you are with Ursa, Band or Football, you will receive move-in details separately. Students a part of these groups move in before August 13 and get keys directly from their building's front desk.

PREPARING FOR YOUR ARRIVAL

- Consider personal property insurance

- Try new things and meet new people!



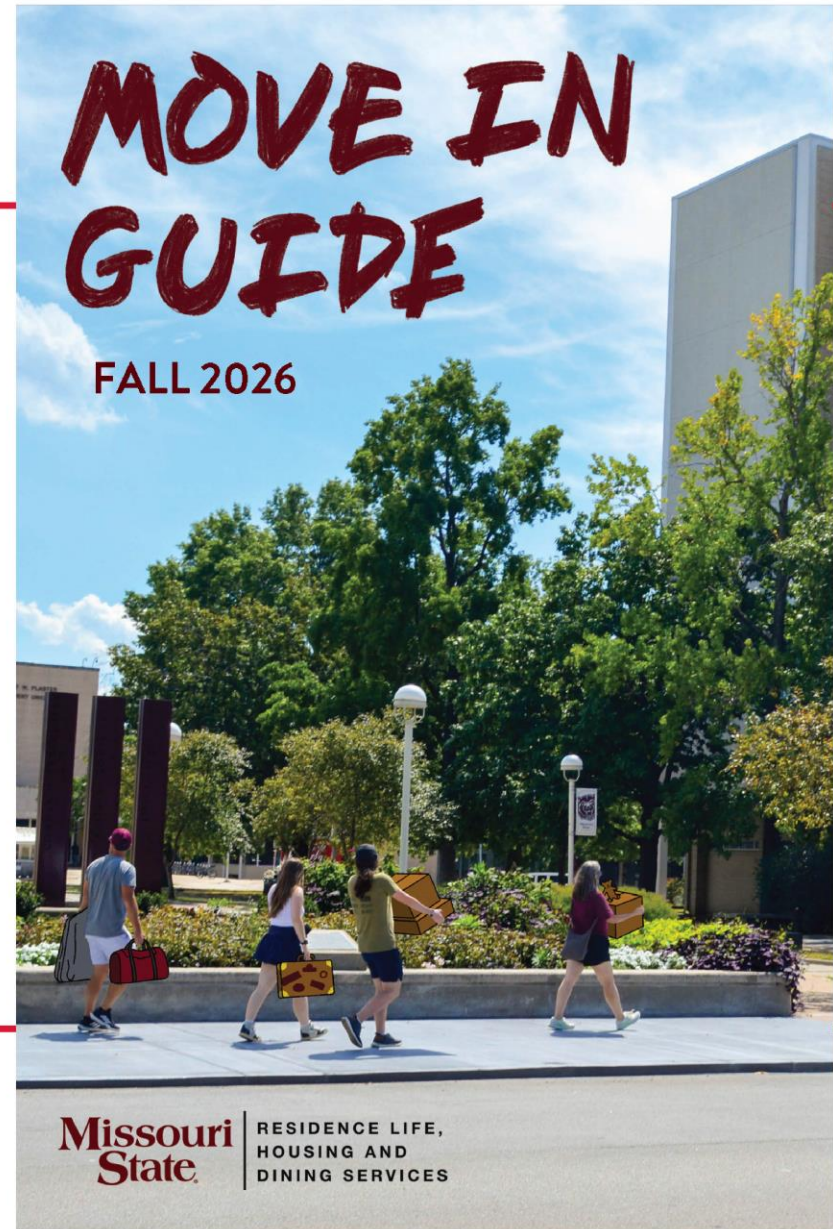
