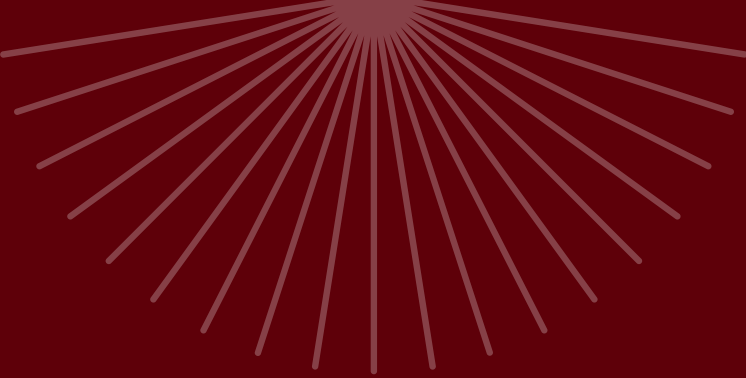

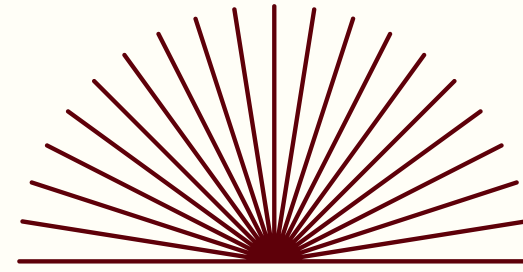

COMMON POLICY VIOLATIONS

ALCOHOL

- Consumption
- Possession
- Distribution
- Public Intoxication
- Paraphernalia

NARCOTICS

- Marijuana is not permitted on university property
 - Possession of smell will be documented too
- This includes medical marijuana
- Students should not share prescription medication

THEFT/DAMAGE

- Traffic signs and parking cones that are kept in the residence hall must have the bill of sale taped to them.
- Includes attempts or actual

begins

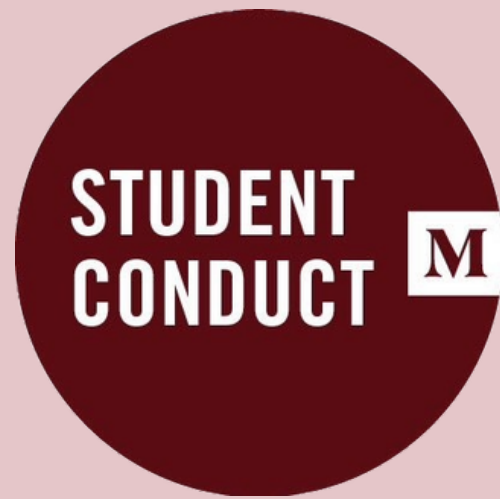
A letter is sent

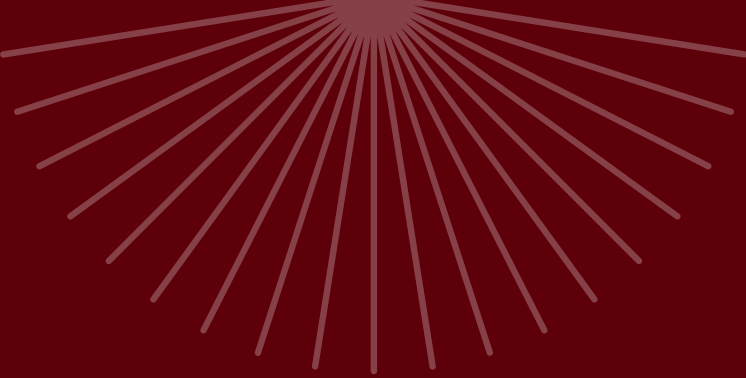

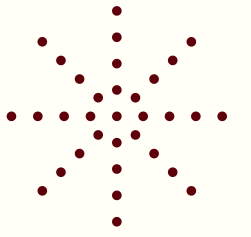
