¹ To access curricular proposals: Log in to MyMissouriState and select the **Work Resources** tab. On the left side, select the following option: Academic / Curricular Proposals / **Curricular Action Forms and Workflow**. On the Curricular Action Workflow page, under View Existing Proposals, click **Filter List of Proposals**. Way down near the bottom, there should be an option to Filter by status. Check any box that indicates CGEIP (in this case, it will say **CGEIP Review; EPPC Review**). Then click <u>Filter Proposals</u>. Options to view the two proposals should appear. Note: Once you have viewed a proposal, you can use the back arrow to go back to the View Existing Proposals page, but you will need to filter again (at least your selected item will still be checked).
