Announcements:

The Ad Hoc Committee on CGEIP completed its work to develop a plan for CGEIP organizational change recommendations and will submit it to the Faculty Senate to be reviewed at its meeting on April 11, 2019. (The Committee gave CGEIP members a paper copy to review during the meeting and to ask questions.)

Approval of Minutes:

Report from CGEIP Ad Hoc Committee delivered by John Strong:

Major recommendations of the report are that CGEIP continue to provide main assessment analysis of General Education Courses and Intercollegiate program courses that are not routed to Educator Preparation Provider Council or Graduate Council; Strongly recommend that the CGEIP Chairperson receive one-course-reassignment per semester that they're in office; New CGEIP membership composition of 39 persons with representative from each of the 34 departments that offer general education courses and representative from the Library, Honors College, First Year Programs, Dual Credit, and Interdisciplinary Programs.

A question was raised about whether Interdisciplinary Programs should have its own group, but no conclusion was drawn.

A question was raised about what annual reviews of general education courses will look like in the future by CGEIP? Keri Franklin is working on this and will put together a clear assessment process, this point is also stated in the CGEIP Ad Hoc Committee Report.

New Business:

Dual Credit and Core 42 and MOTR courses. A new software program will have dual-credit course syllabi downloaded each semester. Those dual credit courses coming through MOTR have an MSU liaison. Issue raised about keeping a balance between increasing MSU enrollment numbers and ensuring quality course content equivalency in dual credit courses.

2019-2020 CGEIP Election for a Chairperson --- LeAnne asked current CGEIP members to please seriously consider serving as Chair. Election to occur next month (in May).
