

## Curricular Proposal Disposition 2025-2026 September 2025

The following proposals have been fully approved through the internal Missouri State University curricular process as outlined by the Constitution and Bylaws of Faculty Senate.

- All curricular decisions will be reflected in the 2026-2027 catalogs published in May 2026.
- The effective term for program changes indicates when those changes will affect student degree requirements; students admitted prior to that effective term will not be automatically impacted by the changes.
- The effective term for new programs indicates when the new program will be available for students to select during admission processes or when continuing students may change to/add that new program.
- The effective term for courses indicates when course updates will affect the class schedule, ahead of that term's registration cycle.
- Pending approval of MDHEWD notes will be added to all new programs/options that require state approval, as well as deleted programs/options and program/option title changes. New programs/options will not be implemented prior to full state approval.
