# I. Call to order

Cathie English called to order the regular meeting of the EPP MSED Committee at 1:07 p.m. on Feb. 14, 2017.

# II. Approval of minutes from last meeting

The minutes from December 5, 2016 were approved.

### III. Old Business

- A. MSED Curricular Changes:
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1. The MSED Curricular Changes passed the Screening Committee and also passed the EPPC on Feb. 8. The changes will go on the graduate council meeting on Feb. 27.

# **IV. New Business**

- A. Collection of Data on Taskstream
  - 1. Discussion of the requirements for collection of data on Taskstream. Jamaine noted that Chris Craig noted at EPPC that we must have 2 collection points for GPA data and indicated there should be three courses for collecting GPA data. Discussion about which courses this would entail, that is 750, 780 and another course. Steve asked if it was possible to do by stream rather than program specific courses. Jamaine Abidogun noted that according to CAEP this was acceptable. Discussion about the value of collecting GPA as an indicator of student progress. Also, Jamaine Abidogun noted that each program (specifically those that don't require 750 or 780) must tell her or Cathie English what courses they will use for the GPA data point collection. Continued discussion about requiring MSED students to purchase Taskstream. There was also discussion about who would be responsible for logging the data in Taskstream, i.e., "Can a program director add an instructor in Taskstream to complete these evaluations?"
  - 2. Jamaine Abidogun moved, seconded by Steve Willis, that the cumulative GPA data be collected at 15 credit hours and 30 credit hours in MSED programs. Passed unopposed.
  - 3. Jamaine Abidogun moved, seconded by Eric Sheffield, that the experiential log data be collected at 15 credit hours and 20 credit hours in MSED programs. Passed unopposed.
  - 4. It was not moved or seconded, but we agreed upon not holding a March meeting due to the conflict with Spring Break. Next meeting is April 11, 2017.

### V. Adjournment
