NEW COURSES

RDG 624 – Analysis & Correction of Difficulties in Adolescent Lit.

Kayla Lewis was present and spoke to the proposal. This course is not relevant for secondary programs matrices since it is for alternative certification.

SCI 783 – Internship in Teaching Sec. Science I

SCI 784 – Internship in Teaching Sec. Science II

Dr. Gigi Saunders was present and spoke to the the proposal. The Science Programs has experienced a drop in student numbers due to the DESE GPA requirements. Students with less than a 3.0 GPA have graduated with degrees in Science instead of education. Therefore, Science is moving to a model where students will attain a BS and take all content courses for certification and then enter the MAT program. These three courses take the place of three courses in the MAT program. Dual credit will be available to high school seniors.

ART 490 – Supervised Teaching
