*** An Alternate Pathway program is one in which the student can complete his or her program without the need for face-to-face, daytime (M-F), Springfield course work. As such these programs are comprised of online, evening/weekend, off-campus, and iCourses-often as a combination of these delivery methods and 100% of a student's courses are delivered in these ways.
