EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2010-2011 ACT-tested freshmen ( 2452) represents ( 23%) of student score reports received by your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students identified by the National Student Clearinghouse as enrolled full time. It is assumed that enrolled students for whom a full-time status was not provided are full-time.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 23.7 (men = 24.0, women = 23.6). The national ACT composite for 2009-2010 high school graduates was 21.0.
