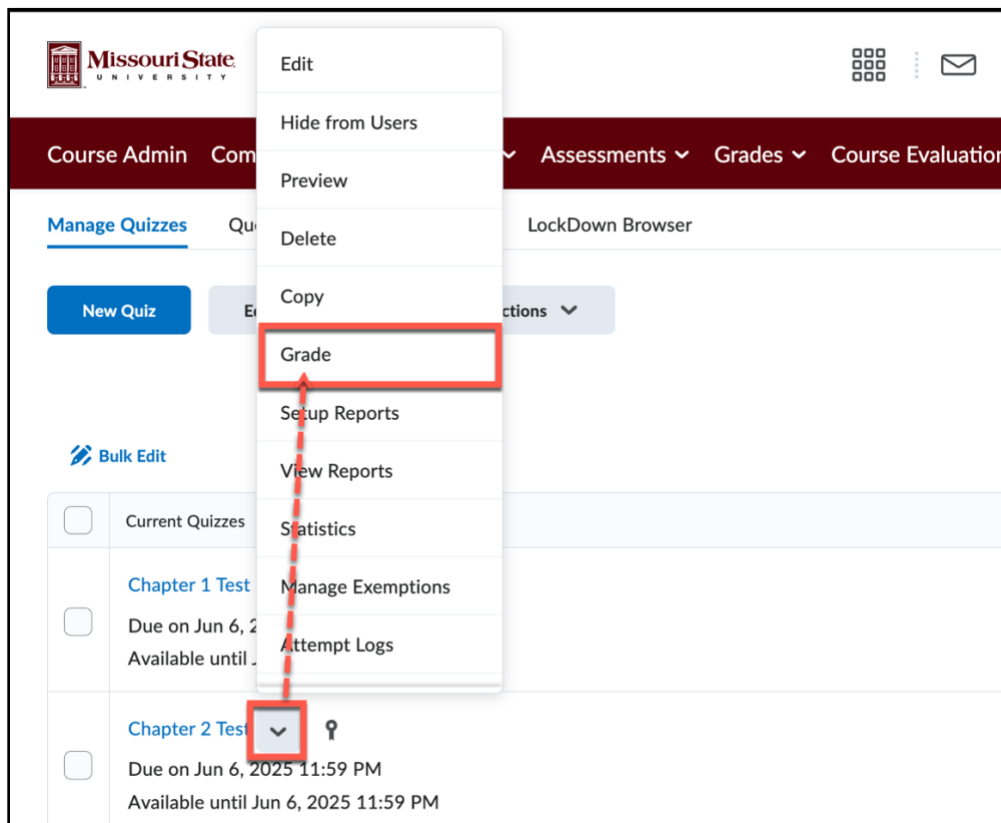


Resetting a Quiz Attempt

Learners may occasionally encounter technical issues during a quiz. If needed, you can reset a quiz attempt to allow the student another opportunity to complete the quiz. This provides flexibility and helps ensure fair access to assessments.

To reset quiz Attempts:

1. On the course navigation menu, select Assessments and choose Quizzes from the list of options.
2. Next, locate the quiz with the attempt you want to reset and access the drop-down menu (located to the right of the quiz title) and select Grade.



3. Select the check box for each attempt you want to reset and then click the Reset button at the top of the list of quiz attempts.
