

## How to Make Question-Specific Feedback Visible to Students in a Quiz

By default, students cannot see the feedback that is left on individual quiz questions unless it has been specifically enabled.

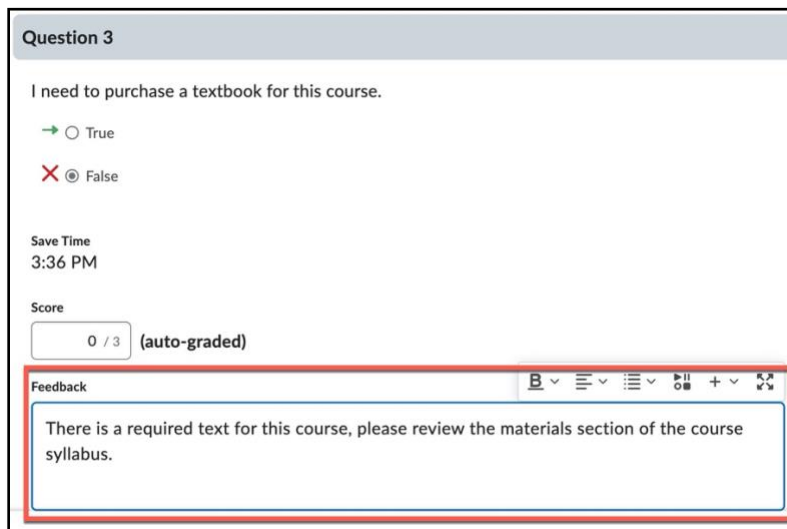


Figure 1: Instructor feedback dialogue box for a quiz question in Brightspace.

To allow students to view question-specific feedback, you will need to adjust the Quiz Results Display settings.

### Steps to Enable Question Feedback Visibility

1. From your course homepage, go to Assessments > Quizzes, then click the quiz you want to edit.
2. Locate the Evaluation & Feedback panel and use the arrow to expand this setting. Next, select the Customize Quiz Results Displays link.

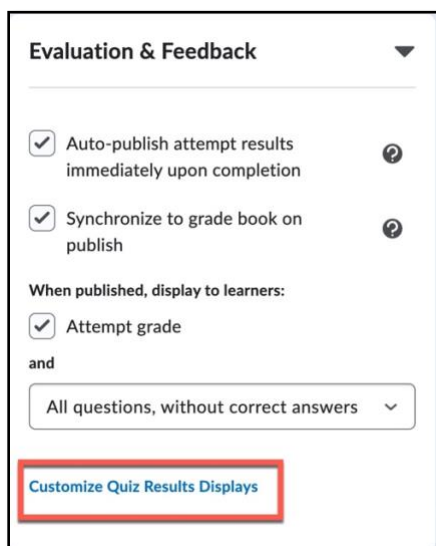
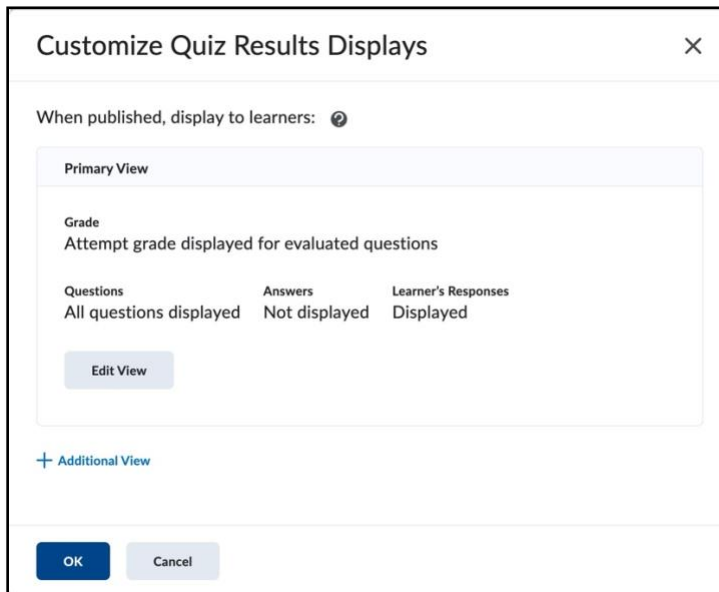


Figure 2: The expanded view of the Evaluation and Feedback section in the quiz canvas in Brightspace.

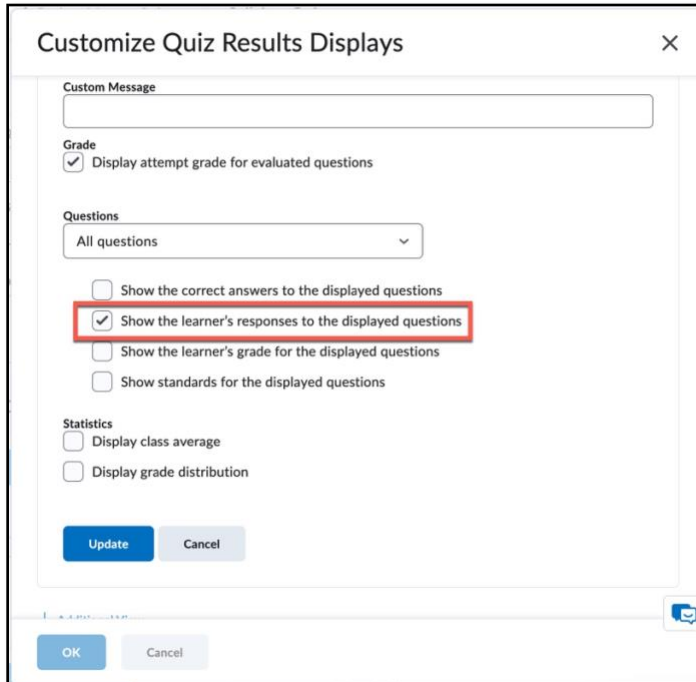
3. Select **Edit View** next to adjust the primary view or select **Add Additional View** if you want to create a new results display option.

4. Under the Questions section, check the box for the option "**show the learner's responses to the displayed questions**".
