Resolution as part of summary report from Faculty Senate Committee on Policy Review

Whereas, the *Faculty Handbook* is the central governing policy that specifies roles and expectations of the faculty including Instructors and Clinical Faculty, and

Whereas, the Policy Library contains a workload policy (OP 3.33) that addresses the parameters for assigning teaching loads and definitions of overload, developed through a joint effort involving faculty and administration but never vetted through the *Faculty Handbook* revision and review process, and

Whereas, it is essential that language for revisions to the *Faculty Handbook* reflect both the operating policy and assurances to address all faculty, and

Whereas, the Faculty Senate Committee on Policy Review recommends a comprehensive vetting of OP 3.33 through the *Faculty Handbook* revision and review process, and

Whereas, the Faculty Senate approved language at the November meeting that may be incongruent with current operating policy and may not provide for workload determinations for non-tenure track faculty,

Therefore, Be it resolved, that the Faculty Senate concurs with the Faculty Senate Committee on Policy Review recommendation that the Workload policy (OP 3.33) be further vetted by the Committee on Policy Review, FHRC, ALC, and AC for integration into the *Faculty Handbook*, thereby providing for a more inclusive and comprehensive description of how faculty workload is determined, including the conditions under which compensation for overload is provided.
