Overload: Determined by evaluating the workload assigned to a faculty member in relation to the standard workload as configured for that faculty member. Thus, if a faculty member with a typical teaching load of 18 equated hours per academic year is asked to teach additional coursework above and beyond average department teaching load workload during a semester an academic year, then upon discussion with the Department Head/Director, that faculty member's workload might be considered overloaded. However, even within a department all courses are not automatically equal.

Note: Pending approval of the Senate, the change in wording for "Overload" will go to the Administrative Council for approval of a policy change.
