

Instructional Technology Advisory Committee FY 2017 Quarterly Report

Highlights

- Currently on the Springfield campus there are a total of 357 technology-enhanced classrooms, of these 153 have been fully upgraded to the digital standard
- All large lecture halls have been upgraded to the digital standard

 - Upgraded previous system to digital standard with improved surround sound capabilities

 - Upgraded room to digital standard, dual-projector system to improve visibility in room

 - Upgraded previous system to digital standard
- McQueary Family Health Sciences Hall 0200 & 0202 (funded by Office of the Provost)
 - Upgraded previous system to digital standard, integrated Mediasite lecture capture system
- Siceluff Hall (24 standard and 1 web conferencing room; funded by Office of the Provost)
 - Upgraded all standard classrooms to digital standard
 - Upgraded SICL 0225 to web conferencing system able to be used with Zoom, Skype for Business, and other web conferencing applications
