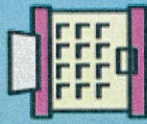

With the completion of the Hill Hall renovation the College of Education temporary offices are scheduled to move to their permanent home.

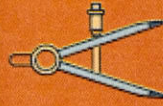

June 29: Michael Mardis is assigned as Project Manager.

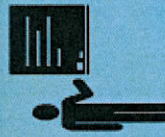

August 15: The work group met with faculty as suggested by their Deans. Ideas from this group resulted to a change in room layout.

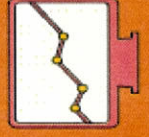
