Training and Communications:

Technical progress:

- Process has been developed for syncing courses, users, and enrollments for both Springfield and West Plains for current semester and one future semester. Work to automate this process is ongoing. China campus Spring 2024 and Springfield and West Plains Summer 2024 courses have been created for any sections that are active in Banner and will continue to be updated.
- Custom applications to allow users to add individual users to academic courses and bulk users to communities is underway. Faculty with immediate needs for users to be added to their current academic courses should submit a ticket with their Brightspace course information and the M-number and role of the user to be added and this will be processed as quickly as possible.
- Campus-wide exams and surveys are being adapted for Brightspace in coordination with Assessment and the Register's Office.
