2. LMS Update Jeff Coiner

D2L Brightspace implementation is progressing as expected. Lacey Gieger is finalizing the SSO setup and SFTP process for bulk course creation and conversion. The URL is ready and working on Brightspace communication configuration. Nancy Gordon is working with D2L to finalize the MSU guided training that will be accessed from the MSU Brightspace platform. We have over 50 early adopters from faculty that will be using Brightspace to teach this Fall. That equates to between 125-150 courses. She is also working on including training in the Showcase for Teaching and Learning, a communication plan, and instructions on how to contact the Brightspace help desk services included in our agreement.

3. ePAF Update Theresa McCoy

MIS is working with Human Resources on the electronic Personnel Action Form. By going to an electronic format, the efficiency of processing personnel actions will be generally increased, as well as reducing the number of mistakes, phone calls, inquiries, etc. It also allows for a history of forms to be kept and better security with data.

4. Mobile Credentials Kevin Piercy

This will increase the students' on-campus experience by virtually accessing a variety of different features. We are working now to solidify the change within the MSU community, progress is current and targeted for mid-September 2023, but might be delayed.

5. Windows 11

We have almost 2,000 windows 11 devices, with the workstations still being a big job. The colleges are working feverishly to get devices up to date. West Plains has their plan on the lifecycle and moving forward. CNAS and research equipment is updating software, but overall, in good shape. We have until October 2025 to complete, and we will continue to discuss at the IT Council meetings. We need to focus on completing and not waiting until the 2025 deadline. We will have better numbers once the Fall 2023 semester begins. Jeff Coiner will take a report to Administrative Council to acknowledge where we are and what we need to do.
