

IT Council – Network Advisory Committee Initial Membership and Charge

The Network Advisory Committee (NAC), reporting to the Information Technology (IT) Council, will be reconvened and will have the responsibility to advise IT Council on matters concerning the University's networking infrastructure and access policies, procedures, funding, and other activities involving network technology, including recommendations for improvements.

Specific charge for the Network Advisory Committee (NAC) for January 2014:

- Identify stakeholder needs and investigate and develop a plan to accomplish the long-range plan goal of 100% wireless coverage within all buildings located on the Springfield campus. The plan should be targeted at improving wireless network access services and be presented to IT Council for review, finalization, and submission to Administrative Council for approval. This plan may include hardware, software, standards, security, policies, and other items deemed appropriate by IT Council. Special attention should be given to investigating central funding models for wireless access for all University faculty, staff, and students as well as an open access wireless guest network.

Network Advisory Committee (NAC) Membership

The Network Advisory Committee (NAC) membership will consist of:

- Chairperson (appointed by the IT Council Chair)
- Networking and telecommunications representative (appointed by the CIO)
- West Plains representative (appointed by the Director of IT – West Plains)
- Faculty Senate representative (appointed by the Faculty Senate Chair)
- User support services representative (appointed by the CIO)
- Information Security Executive Committee representative (appointed by ISEC Chair)
- Campus User Support Committee representative (appointed by the CUSC Chair)
- Student representative (appointed by SGA President)
- Staff member representative (appointed by the Staff Senate Chair)
