




Missouri State. Live Performance is the very nature of Public Affairs

We are excited about your interest in education in music at Missiouri State. Undergraduate and graduate degrees in music are dual admission programs. Students must be admitted to both Missouri State University and the Department of Music in order to major or minor in music.

Begin your application to the University by clicking or scanning the code to the left. Applying for undergraduate admission is free and can be completed online on the Missouri State website. The Graduate College accepts applications for admission through the Graduate **Enrollment Management Centralized Application Service (GradCAS)** main portal, with the exception of some specialized programs and can be begun by clicking or scanning the code to the left as well.
