Contact the **Ombuds office at Missouri State**, a new resource for employees and students.

- **Informal:** Ombuds listen, provide information and help you resolve conflicts informally.
- **Confidential\*:** Meetings are discreet and confidential, held off-campus or on-campus.
- **Impartial:** Ombuds don't take sides or keep permanent records, but can help navigate towards a solution.
- **Independent:** Ombuds may identify problem areas for the university, but do not make policy.
