- **Informal**: Ombuds listen, provide information and help you resolve conflicts informally.
- Confidential*: Meetings are discreet and confidential, held off-campus or on-campus.
- Impartial: Ombuds don't take sides or keep permanent records, but can help navigate towards a solution.
- Independent: Ombuds may identify problem areas for the university, but do not make policy.
