- 1. What is the minimum number of credit (semester) hours required for your CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING degree?**

60

99 students

- 3. How many students graduated from your CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING program in the past year?**

33 (Fall 2020, Spring 2021, & Fall 2021)

- 4. To the best of your knowledge, what is the completion rate of students from your CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING program?**

The completion rate of students in clinical mental health counseling is as follows: Out of 33 students who graduated in 2021- 90% graduated in about three years (mostly 2019 cohort) and 10% graduated in about 3 years.

- 5. To the best of your knowledge, what is the licensure [or certification] examination pass rate of students graduating from your CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING program?**

The examination pass rate for clinical mental health students for the National Counselor Examination (NCE) are as follows: Fall of 2020, 12 candidates took the exam and 12

passed the exam for a 100% pass rate; Spring 2021, 21 candidates took the exam and 18 passed the exam for a pass rate of 91%. Overall for the 2020-2021 year, 33 candidates took the exam and 30 passed the exam for a pass rate of 91%.

- 6. To the best of your knowledge, what is the job placement rate of graduates from your CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING program who were actively seeking employment?**

A poll was electronically distributed to 2021 graduates of the MSU Counseling program. 16 graduates responded and 11 graduates have secured employment.

The completion rate of students in the school counseling program is as follows
Out of 21 school counseling students who graduated in 2021, 90% graduated in about three years. 10 % graduated in four years.

- 5. To the best of your knowledge, what is the licensure [or certification] examination pass rate of students graduating from your SCHOOL COUNSELING program?**

The examination pass rate for school counseling students for the Missouri Content Assessment (MoCA) was as follows: Fall 2020 to Spring 2021, 7 candidates took the examination and 5 passed for a 71% pass rate.
