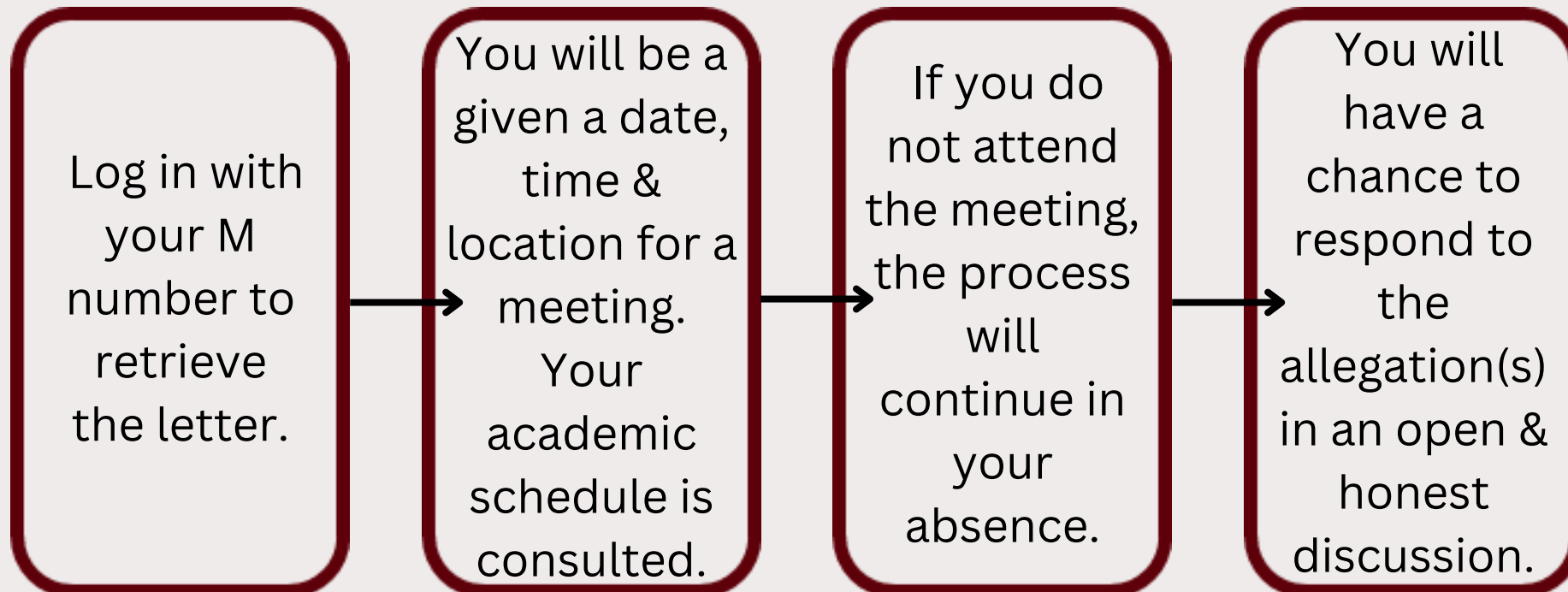


## Student Conduct Process

### What to expect if you receive an email



## Student Rights

- Students will be notified of the alleged violation(s) including the date, time, location and summary of the allegation.
- Students will be notified of the date, time and location of their conduct meeting.
- The meeting will be fair and impartial.
- Students may bring an advisor or support person who can only advise the student.
- Students may appeal the conduct decision.

## Examples of Misconduct

- Alcohol violations
- Drug violations
- Housing policy violations
- Theft or damage
- Facilitating or encouraging policy violations
