December 1st is World Aids Day, but there would not be enough time to organize everything, at least for the upcoming year. Along with bringing the quilt, a 1 ½ hour film could be shown on How to Survive a Plague. We could schedule the quilt for Monday through Friday (dates to be determined) and have the film shown on a Wednesday or Thursday with possibly a small reception afterwards.

Part of the cost is a \$150 non-refundable deposit. Quilt sections, 12' x 12' cost \$500 each. We could get quilts associated with our area.

Who could share with the costs involved? Include outside organizations?

We will meet in June to discuss this further. Once we have a better idea the information will be presented to Staff Senate and taken to the President's Council if needed.
