

Spring 2017 Academic and Programming Report

Scholarship

- The Fraternity and Sorority Life community achieved a 3.20 GPA, which is above the All Campus average of a 3.14 GPA.
- The Interfraternity Council achieved a 3.04 GPA, which is above the All Men's average of a 2.98 GPA.
- The Panhellenic Association achieved a 3.33 GPA, which is above the All Women's average of a 3.25 GPA and All Campus average of a 3.14 GPA.
- 1,212 students, or 40.3% of the community, achieved a "Dean's List" GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- A total of 310 students, or 10.3% of the community, achieved a 4.00 GPA. Sigma Sigma Sigma had the highest percentage of members with a 4.00 GPA at 19%.
- Alpha Delta Pi had the highest chapter GPA in the community with a 3.45 GPA, and Sigma Chi had the highest new member GPA.

Recruitment & Retention

- Twenty-four chapters of the 34 chapters recruited new members. Of the 183 new members recruited, 139 were retained resulting in a 76% retention rate.
- Six chapters achieved 100% retention of their new member classes, and 13 chapters achieved a retention rate above 80%.
- The Fraternity and Sorority Life community now has 3,005 members, an 11.2% increase in membership from the Spring 2016 semester of 2,701 members.

Community Engagement

- The community completed a total of 29,474.80 service hours, a 15.9% increase in service hours from the Spring 2016 semester total of 25,423.20.
- The community completed an average of 7.73 community service hours per member, an increase from Spring 2016 semester of 5.99 hours per member.
- Alpha Delta Pi completed the greatest number of service hours at 3,462 hours. Delta Zeta completed the greatest number of service hours per member at 16.30 hours per member.
- The community donated \$44,486.13 to philanthropic initiatives, an 8.1% increase in philanthropic donations from the Spring 2016 semester total of \$41,145.45.
- At \$18.96 philanthropic donations per member, there was an increase in donations per member from the Spring 2016 semester of \$14.18 per member.
- Lambda Chi Alpha donated the greatest amount of money to philanthropic initiatives at \$5,702.80, and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. donated the greatest amount of money per member at \$157.14 per member.

Educational Programming

- Chapters hosted or attended 95 educational programs with an average of 3 educational programs per chapter.
- There was a 120.9% increase in educational programs from the Spring 2016 semester of 43 educational programs.

Housing

• Of the 18 chapter facilities, the average in house GPA for those chapters was a 3.31 GPA. Sigma Kappa achieved the highest in house GPA at a 3.52.

Organization members may be declared ineligible to campaign for or hold office on their respective governing Council. If found responsible for another violation of University policy and/or a violation of the Governance Statement, it may result in the suspension or dismissal of the organization.
