OTC Year 1 Semester 1
Admission requirements to Child Life include: a one page essay describing your interest in a career to become a Child Life Specialist and the role of a Child Life Specialist, a 3.0 cumulative GPA, 100 hours of verified volunteer experience in a hospital settting, and two letters of recommendation - one must be from the hospital volunteer site. Applications must be submitted by February 1 st prior to junior year
(during year 2 semester 4 while you are still at OTC).


OTC Year 2 Semester 4
Apply to MSU your last semester at OTC by January 1st to start at MSU in fall. Apply to the Child Life program by February 1st year 2 semester 4, while still at OTC, in order to begin Child Life courses upon transfer. Applications are only accepted for this program once per year. Failure to complete admit to Child Life requirements and the application by February 1st year 2 semester 4 , will result in a delay of graduation.
