#### OTC Year 1 Semester 1

Admission requirements to Child Life include: a one page essay describing your interest in a career to become a Child Life Specialist and the role of a Child Life Specialist, a 3.0 cumulative GPA, 100 hours of verified volunteer experience in a hospital setting, and two letters of recommendation - one must be from the hospital volunteer site. Applications must be submitted by February 1st prior to junior year (during year 2 semester 4 while you are still at OTC).
