 - Submitting a formal application, with accompanying forms, to the School of Social Work office. Applications for admission to the Program will be available online.
 - Verify the application due dates with the MSU Transfer Advisor as dates can vary.
 - Admission is competitive and selective and not all who apply can be accommodated. Meeting the minimum standards does not guarantee a student will be admitted.
