 Students require a minimum major GPA of 3.00 and a combined GPA (Missouri State and transfer) of 2.75 as a part of approval for supervised teaching.

Teacher education program requirements:

- At least a 2.75 GPA on all course work attempted at all colleges attended
 At least a 3.00 GPA in professional education courses
- At least a 3.00 GPA in any additional certificate subject area
