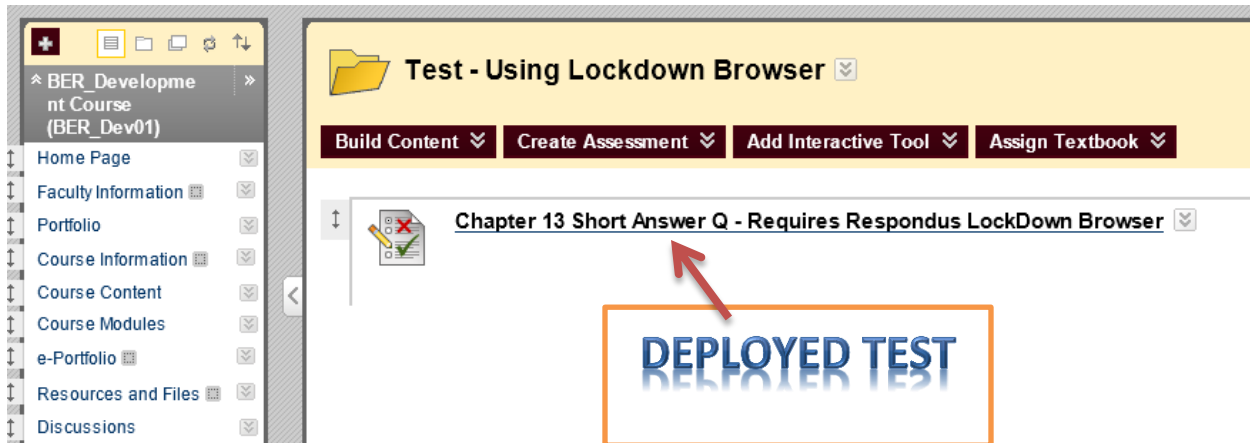


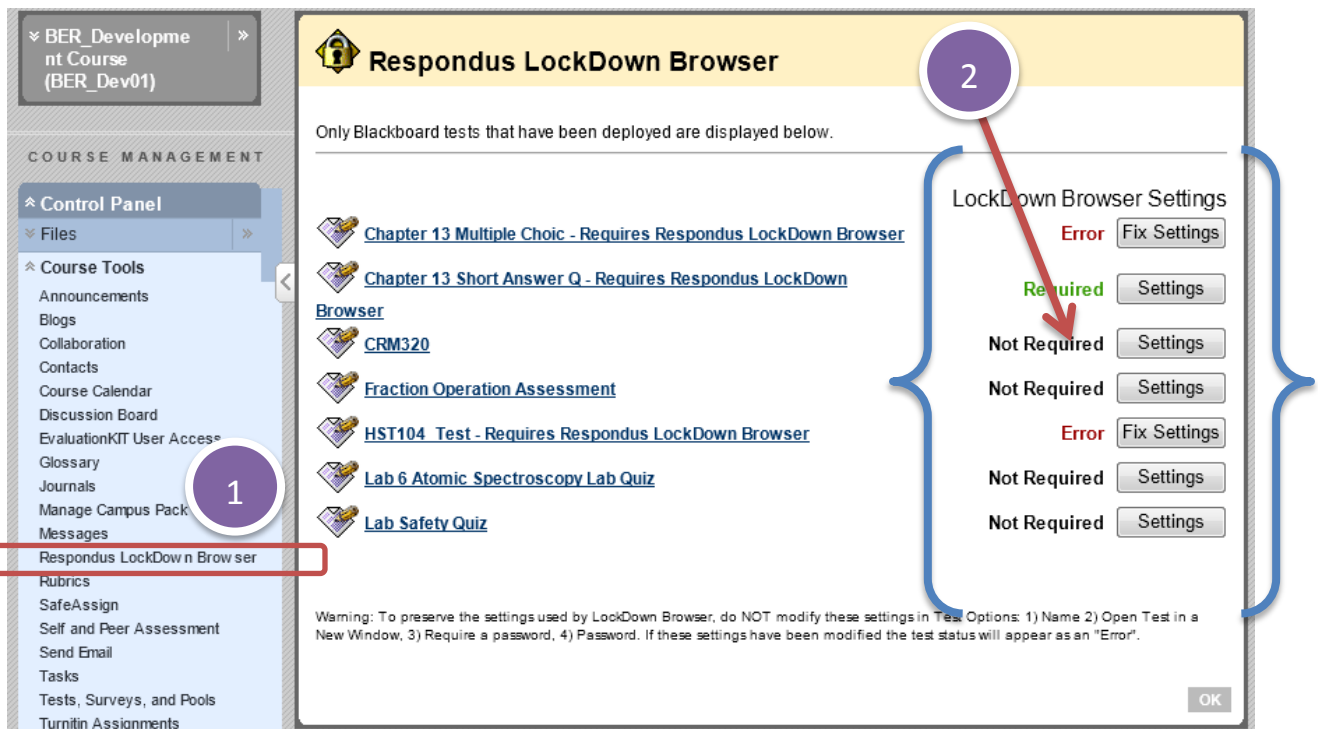
Adding Respondus LockDown Browser to your Blackboard Assessment

This tutorial will show Faculty how to add the **Respondus LockDown Browser** to their Blackboard assessment so that they can lock the student's test environment as they complete the Blackboard test or quiz. **Respondus LockDown Browser** is a custom browser that locks down the testing environment within the Blackboard learning system. Students are locked into the assessment and are unable to print, copy, go to another URL, or access other applications.

First create your assessment in Blackboard and deploy it.




In Control Panel click Course Tools and find the Respondus LockDown Browser tool. You will see all Blackboard tests displayed. They will be listed as **Not Required** for the LockDown Browser setting.



Click **Settings** for the test you wish to apply the LockDown Browser.

Adding Respondus LockDown Browser to your Blackboard Assessment

Change the option for the assessment to be “Require Respondus LockDown Browser for this test”.



Respondus LockDown Browser

Test password (optional)

2. LockDown Browser Exit Password

Exit password for closing the browser during the quiz (optional)

*You can create a test password if you like. (*Optional*)

*You can create a password that will allow for the browser to be closed in case of an emergency for a student. (*Optional*)

Click **Submit**.

Adding Respondus LockDown Browser to your Blackboard Assessment

The test is now required to be taken using the LockDown Browser.

Warning: To preserve the settings used by LockDown Browser, do NOT modify these settings in Test Options: 1) Name 2) Open Test in a New Window, 3) Require a password, 4) Password. If these settings have been modified the test status will appear as an "Error".

Click **OK**.

Go back to your test. In this example it is on the Course Content page.

Begin: CRM320 - Requires Respondus LockDown Browser

Cancel Begin

1. Instructions

Force Completion This Test can be saved and resumed later.
Click **Begin** to begin: CRM320 - Requires Respondus LockDown Browser. Click **Cancel** to go back.
Note that you will be previewing this assessment and not actually taking it when you continue.

2. Submit

Notice how it states **Requires Respondus LockDown Browser**.

Adding Respondus LockDown Browser to your Blackboard Assessment

Your test setting is now completed and can be given through the Respondus LockDown Browser.

When the students begin the test in Respondus LDB, tell them to click begin. If you created a password they will need to enter it here. If you did NOT provide a password, tell them to click No and they will be able to start the test.
