#### <sup>1</sup> Cohorts:

The total number of fulltime, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates less any exclusions. Institutions are permitted to exclude from the cohort: students who died or were totally and permanently disabled, those who left school to serve in the armed forces or were called up to active duty, those who left to serve with a foreign aid service of the federal government (such as the Peace Corps), and those who left to serve on an official church mission.

#### <sup>2</sup> Graduation Rates:

The total number of individuals from a given cohort who completed a degree or certificate within a given percent of normal time to complete all requirements of the degree or certificate program before the ending status date of August 31; divided by the total number of students in the cohort minus any allowable exclusions.

Graduation Rates are reported annually by February. This report was updated September 2016.
